

**21<sup>st</sup> Century After-school Elementary Community Learning Centers**  
**Emergency Weather Cancellation Plan**  
**(PLEASE KEEP TOP HALF OF SHEET)**

Weather or mechanical breakdowns sometimes require early or emergency dismissal **during** the school day. District-wide emergency dismissals are announced on the television and radio stations listed on the reverse side of this page. Parents are also able to access school cancellations using the Internet by logging on to the Wausau School District homepage at [www.wausau.k12.wi.us](http://www.wausau.k12.wi.us) and selecting *Check for School Delays*.

- All after-school programs in the District are cancelled in the event of a District-wide early dismissal.
- In some instances, there is not an early school day dismissal but the District may issue an announcement that **all** after-school programs are cancelled due to weather. When this occurs, all 21<sup>st</sup> Century programs will be cancelled as well.

**This Emergency Weather Cancellation Plan addresses those times when there is not an early dismissal and the District has not cancelled all after-school programs, but weather conditions are worsening.**

- 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers may announce cancellation of 21<sup>st</sup> Century after-school programs (independent of a District decision) to assure safety of students, staff, and volunteers in its programs at the following schools: Hawthorn Hills, John Marshall, Franklin, Lincoln, Stettin, Thomas Jefferson, Grant and GD Jones. This decision will be announced by **1:00 PM** on television and radio stations listed on the reverse side. (This may precede a District-wide decision.)

If after-school programs must be cancelled, we would like to know that you have made plans for your child(ren). Please complete the form below and return it to your After-school Coordinator. Discuss the plan with your child/children. It is difficult for students to telephone for instructions at these times, so we will keep a copy of your after-school plan on file. *Please plan ahead to assure the safety of your child and inform us of any changes in this plan. It is the responsibility of parents to be attentive to cancellations and to act accordingly to your child's plan in the event of a cancellation. Children must be picked up promptly at the close of the regular school day if not designated to walk home or ride the bus.*
