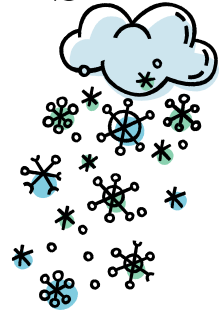
**General Guidelines for "Kids on the Grow"**
